THE SHIRE PRESIDENT'S REPORT



PRESIDENT'S REPORT SEPTEMBER 2022

On Wednesday 7th September 2022, Christine Boase, Manager Community and Environmental Officers Rose Lane and Matt Stringmore from Anglo Gold Ashanti Australia met with Cr's Sudhir, Dwyer (via phone), I Baird (via video), Acting CEO and myself, for an update on how Tropicana Goldmine is going. Talks also included plans to increase renewable energy options and the updating of the Mine Closure Plan.

With Cr Dwyer and ACEO, we attended the Northern Goldfields Working Group Meeting in Leonora on the 16th, which included Phil Marshall ACEO, Laverton, Gary Gaffney, CEO Wiluna, Jim Epis, CEO Leonora, Chair, Peter Craig, President Leonora Shire and Kris Starcevich, CEO GEDC who spoke at length on the Project Running Sheet. Matters of interest that was discussed were the Summer Response actions and the Voluntary Liquor Accord.

Following on from the NGWG meeting the Golden Quest Discovery Trail Association conducted a General Meeting. The City of Kalgoorlie Boulder and the Shire of Coolgardie will be written to regards joining the Association as financial and voting members.

On the evening of Friday 16th, Cr Dwyer and myself, by invitation, attended the City of Kalgoorlie Boulder Art Prize at the Goldfields Art Centre. The "Best Overall Winner" "All Consuming" by Savannah Morrison and also the "Best Artwork by Kalgoorlie/Boulder Artist.

I attended the Audit and Risk Committee meeting with Cr Sudhir. After lunch we attended the Briefing Session with Cr's Tucker and Warner.

Cr Dwyer and I were invited to the Anangu-Tjukurra Indigenous Protected Area (also known colloquially as Spinifex IPA) ceremony. We travelled to Tjuntjuntjara via Neale Junction to Ilkulka, staying overnight Monday 26th and travelled to Tjuntjuntjara via Aboriginal Business Road on Tuesday for a lunch time ceremony.

SHIRE NOTES

The September Council Meeting was held on Thursday, 29 in Tjuntjuntjara. The meeting was attended in person by all Councillors. Mr Gary Kairn, CEO of Paupiyala Tjarutja Aboriginal Corporation (Tjuntjuntjara) updated the Councillors on activities and projects at Tjuntjuntjara and provided a tour of the new medical centre, which is nearing completion.

The meeting was also attended by Bruce Lorrimer and Milena Lorsignol from Core Business Australia. Council has engaged Core Business to progress upgrading works on the Tjuntjuntjara access road.

Decisions made at the meeting include:

1. Acceptance of a quote of \$756,748.00 from Evoke Living Homes for the design and construction of two 2x1 accommodation units to be located on 29 Reid Street, Menzies.
2. Awarded the contract associated with Tender 01/22- Sectional upgrades of Shire of Menzies roads to seal standards to Monarch Ventures Pty Ltd trading as Roadtech Civil and Construction for the lumpsum price of \$2,731,669.00.
3. Considered a request from Digital Radio Systems Pty Ltd for the siting of a 55m high communications mast in the Menzies Townsite, either on Lot 561 Suiter Street or Lot 3001 Ballard Street, Menzies.

The purpose of the mast is to facilitate highspeed internet to mining companies in the Menzies area. The service will also be available to the Menzies Community.

Council resolved as follows:

That Council advise the applicant that it supports the siting of a communications mast upon either 100 (Lot 561) Suiter Street, Menzies or 15 (Lot 3001) Ballard Street, Menzies and issue delegated authority to the Shire CEO to approve the necessary planning and building approvals subject to the following conditions:

- a) The applicant must obtain all necessary consent/tenure agreement of the landowner relevant to the site and the access to the site.*
 - b) The applicant must submit all necessary information to enable the assessment of the planning and building permit applications.*
 - c) That the structure complies with civil aviation requirements in respect to the Menzies airstrip.*
4. Established a Tourism and Economic Development Committee, comprising Councillors, staff and community representatives.

MILPA, the Spinifex Arts Project, Tjuntjuntjara 2022

The WA Primary Health Alliance (WAPHA) grants form part of a [National Suicide Prevention Trial](#) to support suicide prevention initiatives in some of the state's most at-risk communities. With the support of the WAPHA Mental Health awareness grant, the Shire of Menzies working closely with the Spinifex Arts Project (SAP) from Tjuntjuntjara Community to start a project titled Milpa stories in July 2022. It is a series of community art workshops where people from across the Tjuntjuntjara Community were able to come and gain new skills, work together and create art and films. This was a catalyst for important discussions about positive mental health and healthy life choices. Artists focused on completing a series of artworks for a short stop-motion film that focused on the negative impacts of drinking alcohol in remote communities.

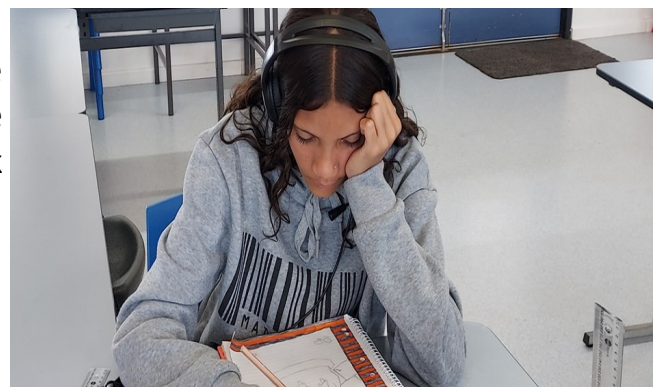


From the Wanampi Classroom:

Menzies celebrates 'discovery'

The community of the northern Goldfields town of Menzies is preparing to celebrate its foundation for the first time this month.

Menzies Discovery Day will take place on October 15 – with October 1894 being when Leslie Robert Menzie registered the first gold claim in the area.

Shire of Menzies community development specialist Almetra Bethlehem said a long-term resident suggested the idea, and it would be the first time in many years the community would celebrate something so significant.

"Incorporating First Nations history, European settlement and other events, this day of celebration will be utilised to extend the length of the tourism season and introduce others to the charms of this special region," she said.

She said the event would benefit the community by providing them with a range of activities to do while also connecting them with government authorities, volunteer organisations, mining companies and local businesses.

"This event will bring more interaction among the local population and showcase the potential of the region to attract

additional residents and tourism opportunities," Ms Bethlehem said.

She said the Menzies Community Resource Centre applied for a Horizon Power Local Community Partnerships grant in March and successfully secured major funding for the event, but also approached other sponsors to create a "bigger and better" celebration.

The celebration will be at the Menzies Sports Oval and Ngalipaku Building (Youth Centre) area and will run from 9am to 9.30pm.

Old-fashion race games, historical walking tours and live music will be offered at the free-entry event, as well as a gold detecting competition.

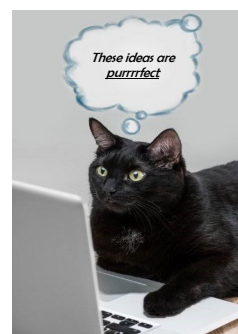

SEVEN GOLDEN RULES FOR PROSPECTING

1.

Put safety first

- Make sure you have enough water, fuel, maps and first aid supplies.
- Give serious consideration to taking some form of telecommunications and a global positioning system to fix locations, and a Personal Locator Beacon (PLB) – it may turn out to be your most important safety device.

2.

Obtain a Miner's Right permit

when prospecting on vacant Crown land (\$25 from any Mining Registrar's office).

3.

Obtain a 40E permit

prior to prospecting within an exploration tenement (if you don't have written permission from the tenement holder).

4.

Get written permission

from the tenement holder when prospecting on:

- a mining lease
- an exploration licence (if you don't have a 40E permit)
- a prospecting licence

5.

Comply with all legal requirements

when prospecting on a pastoral lease. You cannot prospect within 100 metres of any occupied building or within 400 metres of any livestock watering point without the consent of the pastoralist.

6.

Show respect when on Crown land

because it is used by other people or set aside for many purposes.

7.

Fill any holes

that you dug and repair ground that has been disturbed.

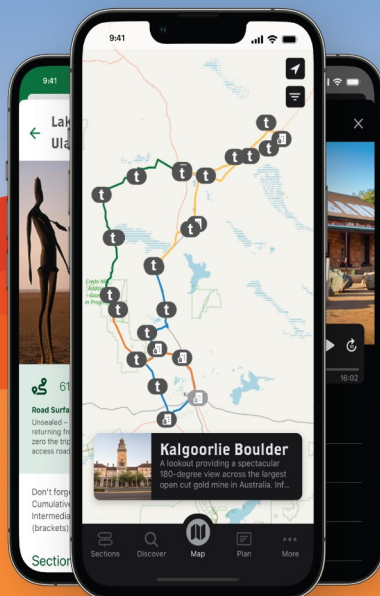
